Christmas

A £200.00 deposit per person is required to confirm your reservation, a further deposit of 50% of the cost of your stay is required by the 1st April and full payment by the 1st September. If the payments are not received by these dates, the reservation will be cancelled and any deposits forfeited. The deposits are non refundable unless the hotel is closed and unable to accept guests, therefore we strongly recommend that you take out holiday insurance.

Deposits for New Year

A non-refundable deposit equivalent to the cost of the first night of your stay per person is payable to confirm your booking and will be deducted from your bill on departure.

Cancellation for New Year

In all cases the deposit is forfeited and in addition if the booking is cancelled within 30 days of the arrival date – 100% of the total value of the reservation will be charged of which the deposit is part.
